- 4. Number of participating students is limited to two students from each school. The Principal of the participating School may decide the process of writing and selection of the essays at the school level. The process should be transparent. IDA does not take any responsibility of any dispute at the School level.

The essay and the certificate from the Principal of the School should be enclosed in an envelope superscribing on the envelop "ESSAY FOR MILK DAY" and the envelope be enclosed in another envelope which should be sent by post or by hand so as to reach before October 10, 2013 at the following Address(s):

The Essays would be adjudged by a panel of judges approved by the Chairman IDA (NZ), New Delhi.
