## STRUCTURE OF QUESTION PAPER

1. All questions are compulsory.
2. The question paper is divided into five sections $\mathbf{A}, \mathbf{B}, \mathbf{C}, \mathbf{D}$ and $\mathbf{E}$.
3. There are 33 questions in all. Some questions have internal choice. Marks are indicated against each question.

## Section - A

Objective Type Questions: This section comprises 16 questions (from 1 to 16). These are objective type questions carry 1 mark each. This type may include questions with one word to one sentence answers/fill in the blanks/true or false/ multiple choice type questions.

Long Answer Questions: this section will have 2 questions (from $31 \& 32$ ) each one with internal choice. Each question will carry 6 marks. Answer to each question should be in 150 - 200 words.

## Section-E

Source Based Question: This section will have a single question (33) of 12 marks based on the comprehensive paragraph. All the questions asked must be one mark while one question of Match the following ( 6 marks) should be part of these questions.
