STRUCTURE OF QUESTION PAPER (THEORY)

- The question paper will cover 50% of the whole syllabus.
- There are 3 parts in the question paper i.e. Part A, Part- B and Part- C. Part- A is compulsory for all the students and students may choose only one section from Part- B and Part- C. Part- A, Part- B and Part- C will be set from Term – II of the syllabus.
- 6 Questions will be set in the question paper.
- All units of the syllabus should be given adequate representation in the question paper.
- There is no word, line or page limit for numerical questions.
- The use of non-programmable simple calculator is allowed.

PART-A

Question No. 1 consists of 8 sub parts (i to viii) carrying 2 marks each. Objective type questions may include questions with one word to one sentence answer/ fill in the blank/true or false/multiple choice type questions.

Question No. 2 will carry 3 marks with internal choice. Answer of theoretical question should be given in 4-8 lines.

Question No. 3 will carry 4 marks with internal choice. Answer of theoretical question should be given in 10-15 lines.

PART-B

Question No. 4 consists of 5 sub parts (i to v) carrying 2 marks each. Objective type questions may include questions with one word to one sentence answer/ fill in the blank/true or false/multiple choice type questions.

Question No. 5 will carry 3 marks with internal choice. Answer of theoretical question should be given in 4-8 lines.

Question No. 6 will carry 4 marks with internal choice. Answer of theoretical question should be given in 10-15 lines.

PART-C

Question No. 4 consists of 5 sub parts (i to v) carrying 2 marks each. Objective type questions may include questions with one word to one sentence answer/ fill in the blank/true or false/multiple choice type questions.
